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### 2. Program Name: CA Arcot WebFort

### 3. Specified Operating Environment

The CA Software's specifications and specified operating environment information may be found in the Documentation accompanying the CA Software, if available (e.g., a user manual, user guide, or readme.txt or notice.txt file). “Documentation” means (a) with respect to CA Software: only standard specifications, user documentation, and technical manuals and guides provided with the CA Software (some or all of which may be in English only) and (b) with respect to Maintenance and warranty support: CA’s external policies covering the scope and nature of Maintenance and warranty support available to CA customers can be found at <http://www.support.ca.com>.

### 4. Licensing Model

CA Arcot WebFort is licensed by the number of User Credentials and Users.

“Credential” means an attestation of qualification, competence, or authority issued to a User by the CA Software.

“User” means a single person, or identity, listed in any Customer directory or network storage location whose access and use rights can be authenticated, authorized, or administered by CA Arcot WebFort or who has the ability to view content aggregated or managed by CA Arcot WebFort. In general, a user shall not be counted more than once or on a concurrent (logged-in) basis.

“User Credentials” means the number of Credentials set forth on the Order Form to be issued to the Users who are authorized to access and use CA Arcot WebFort. Each User may have more than one credential for different verification methods.

“ArcotID Client” or “ArcotOTP Client” means portions of CA Arcot WebFort which enable end-users to use the ArcotID and ArcotOTP credentials.

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### 5. Licensing terms

5.1. License grant. The license granted to Customer is a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable and territory wide license. The “Territory” is specified in the applicable order form, in the section entitled “Territory”. Customer’s use of the license shall extend to use by Customer and Customer’s Authorized End Users. “Authorized End Users” means Customer and Customer’s Affiliate’s employees and independent contractors (but excluding any outsourcer, facilities management providers or application service provider). Use of the CA Software by Authorized End Users shall at all times remain Customer’s responsibility and liability. Customer may use the CA Software for the operation of Customer’s Affiliate’s



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
